LAS VEGAS – February 10, 2025 – WBC Super Lightweight World Champion **Alberto Puello** shared updated from his training camp and previewed his upcoming showdown against top-rated mandatory challenger **Sandor Martin** before they meet on Saturday, March 1 as part of a loaded PBC Pay-Per-View event on Prime Video from Barclays Center in Brooklyn.

The pay-per-view features four title fights and is headlined by boxing superstar and reigning WBA Lightweight World Champion **Gervonta** "Tank" Davis dueling WBA Super Featherweight World Champion Lamont Roach. Plus, WBA Super Lightweight World Champion Jose "Rayo" Valenzuela will take on hard-hitting top contender **Gary Antuanne Russell** in the co-main event, while rising star **Yoenis Tellez** battles former unified world champion **Julian** "J-Rock" **Williams** for the Interim WBA Super Welterweight Title in the pay-per-view opener at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT.

In addition to the PPV being available for purchase on Prime Video, regardless of Prime membership, fans will also be able to continue to access the telecast through traditional cable and satellite outlets as well as PPV.com.

Here is what Puello (23-0, 10 KOs) had to say about facing Martin, training camp with Ismael Salas and more:

On training camp with famed trainer Ismael Salas in Las Vegas:

"I'm pushing myself to be the best. Every day we're in the gym sharpening my skills, working on my movement and making sure I'm in top shape. Coach Salas has a great eye for detail, so we're focused on the little things that will make a big difference in the ring. We're making sure I'm going to be the best Alberto Puello that anyone has seen."

On facing Sandor Martin:

"Sandor Martin is going to be a tough challenge. He's the number one contender for a reason. He's got a smart and complicated style, but we've been studying him closely. I'm preparing to take away his strengths and impose my own game plan. When that bell rings, I'll be ready for whatever he brings."

On what a win would say about his standing in the super lightweight division:

"The only thing I'm envisioning is a win and keeping my unbeaten record. This win not only strengthens my status as world champions, but it creates the opportunity for even bigger matchups. I'm here to show that I'm the best champion in the 140-pound division. This fight is a huge opportunity to prove that to the world."

On fighting in New York for the first time as a pro:

"Fighting at Barclays Center in Brooklyn for the first time is going to be special. I hear the energy in New York is different, and I know the fans are going to bring their passion. I'm very proud to be representing the Dominican Republic in New York and I hope the fans come out to see me do it in style. When I step in the ring and they see how I fight, I know they're going to love it. I can't wait to put on a show and give them a performance they won't forget."

ABOUT TANK VS. ROACH

Davis vs. Roach will see boxing superstar and reigning WBA Lightweight World Champion **Gervonta** "**Tank**" **Davis** take on WBA Super Featherweight World Champion **Lamont Roach** in a lightweight title clash that headlines a loaded PBC Pay-Per-View event on Prime Video taking place Saturday, March 1 from Barclays Center in Brooklyn.

The pay-per-view undercard will WBA Super Lightweight World Champion José "Rayo" Valenzuela will take on hard-hitting top contender Gary Antuanne Russell in the co-main event, plus WBC Super Lightweight World Champion Alberto Puello defends his title against top-rated mandatory challenger Sandor Martín in a pay-per-view attraction. Kicking off the pay-per-view at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT, rising star Yoenis Téllez will take on former unified world champion Julian "J-Rock" Williams for the Interim WBA Super Welterweight Title.

The streaming presentation will feature former unified 154-pound world champion "Swift" Jarrett Hurd taking on hard-hitting Johan Gonzalez in a 10-round middleweight affair, plus undefeated rising super featherweight contender Jonathan "La Roca" Lopez faces U.K. contender Alex Dilmaghani for a 10-round fight.
